Report on Road Safety Activities

Introduction:

Road Safety Club has been formed to create awareness among the students as well as local people in consonance with the Director of Transport, Himachal Pradesh, Shimal-1 letter No TPT-LA(16)/RSC Payment & Expenditure/2021-445 dated 06 Jan 2022, read in conjunction with Director of Higher Education, Himachal Pradesh Shimla letter No. EDN-HE(21)F(10)13/2021-Road Safety dated 24 Jan 2022. The aim of this club is to create road safety awareness among the students and improve their knowledge as well as skill to reduce the accidents and develop young ambassadors to take up this to each individual and see that no one should die on road.

Himachal Pradesh is a hilly state and many people die every year in road accidents. Therefore, this campaign of the Govt has a special significance to the states with hilly terrain. The trickle down effect of this campaign will unambiguously reduce the death rate due to road accidents.

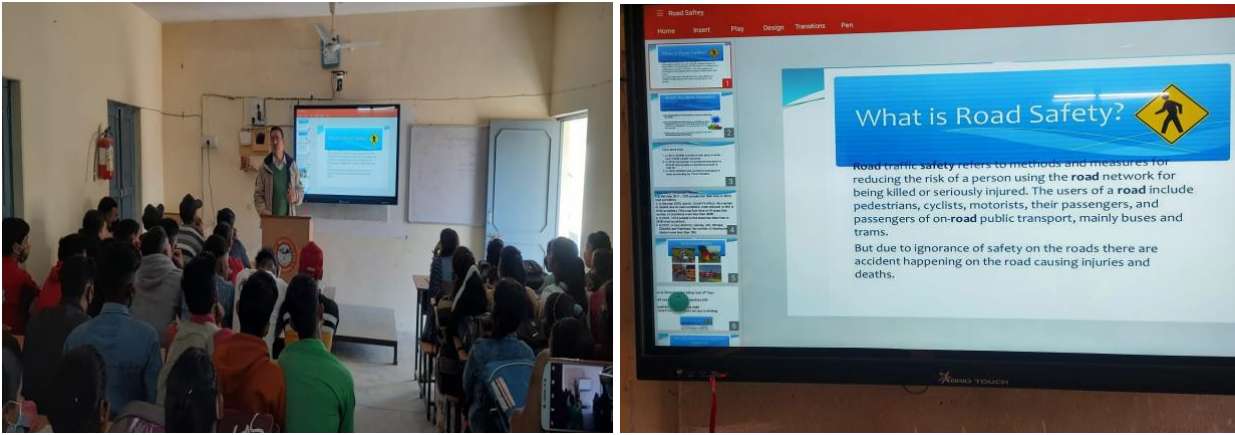
Govt. Degree College, Rey also intends to inculcate the feelings of the responsibility among the students towards the road safety measures. To achieve this goal, various activities were conducted in the month of Feb/Mar 2022 and the club is determined to conduct such activities in future also. Road safety club mainly focus on changing mindsets of the students towards safe driving and first aid training.

Objectives of Road Safety Club

- To make the students understand the road safety and traffic rules and regulations.
- To provide an opportunity to students to be more familiar with road safety education.
- To decrease the number of road accidents and injury cases by applying the road safety measures
- To encourage the travellers to follow traffic rules and wear helmet and seat belt while driving.
- To make people aware about the speed limit of the vehicles to prevent road accidents.
- To make disciplined movement of traffic on the road.

Road Safety Awareness Lectures

Road Safety lecture was organised on 11th Feb 2022 under the banner of Road Safety Club. The lecture was delivered by Officiating Principal Sh. Shashi Bhushan. He explained in detail, the need of Road Safety measures in the present fast moving world, where road transport is being used in all spheres of life. The students of the college attended the lecture with great zeal and enthusiasm. During the lecture, students were informed that Road traffic accidents are one of the world's biggest hazards which can be prevented only by strictly following the traffic rules and safety measures. The students were educated to use helmets, seatbelt, avoid using mobile phones while driving and driving if drunk. The students were also motivated to check others indulged in breaking traffic rules to ensure safety of everyone. The lecture was conducted as an interactive session wherein the quantum of queries raised by students were addressed. The students appreciated the efforts of the "Road safety club" spreading awareness on issues which can results in saving precious lives.



Essay writing competition

Essay writing competition on road safety awareness was organized by Road Safety Club under the able guidance of Prof. Surinder Kumar on 15th Feb 2022. 11 students participated in this competition. The topics of the essay were 'Basic Rules of Road Safety', 'The Need of Awareness about Road Safety' and 'The Role of Students in Road Safety'. Students express their views about the road safety. Kamna of B. Com bagged first prize, while Manisha Kumari and Vishal Kumar of BA-III secured second and third position in the competition. The efforts of the students were appreciated by the Principal and staff members.



Declamation Competition

Declamation competition on road safety was organized by Road Safety Club of GDC Rey under the aegis of Prof. Pankaj Chandak on 17th Feb 2022. Most of the participants discussed the importance of road safety, causes of accidents and preventive measures thereto. The first, second and third prizes were bagged by Kamna, Rita and Vishal Kumar respectively.



Poster making and slogan writing

Poster making and slogan writing competition was organized in GDC Rey by Road Safety Club under the guidance of Prof. Surjeet Singh on 20th Feb 2022. The objectives of the competition were to ignite the fire of imagination and creativity among the students. The students were asked to express their thoughts and ideas through display multiple paintings and sketches. In poster making Saloni Rani, Renu Bala, and Kamna Devi secured first, second and third rank respectively. In slogan writing Mahima Choudhary, Isha and Simran got first, second and third position respectively.



Road Safety Rally

A rally for road safety was organized in GDC Rey under the aegis of Sh Subhash Singh, Asstt. Lib and Dr. Rajesh Kumar on 03rd March 2022. The rally started from college campus and culminated at civil hospital Rey via college road. The rally was addressed by Sh Bhajan Singh, ASI, Police Station Rey. He advised students to obey the traffic rules strictly and also to wear helmet as well as seat belt while driving. In addition to this, seven slogan have been painted at various places in Gram Panchayat Rey.

Prize distribution ceremony was organised on 09th March 2022 in Smart

Classroom at GDC Rey. The Chief Guest of the event was Principal GDC Rey. The chief guest felicitated the students who won the various competitions organised during the road safety month. The prizes were in the form of cash and mementos were given away to the winners of various categories.
